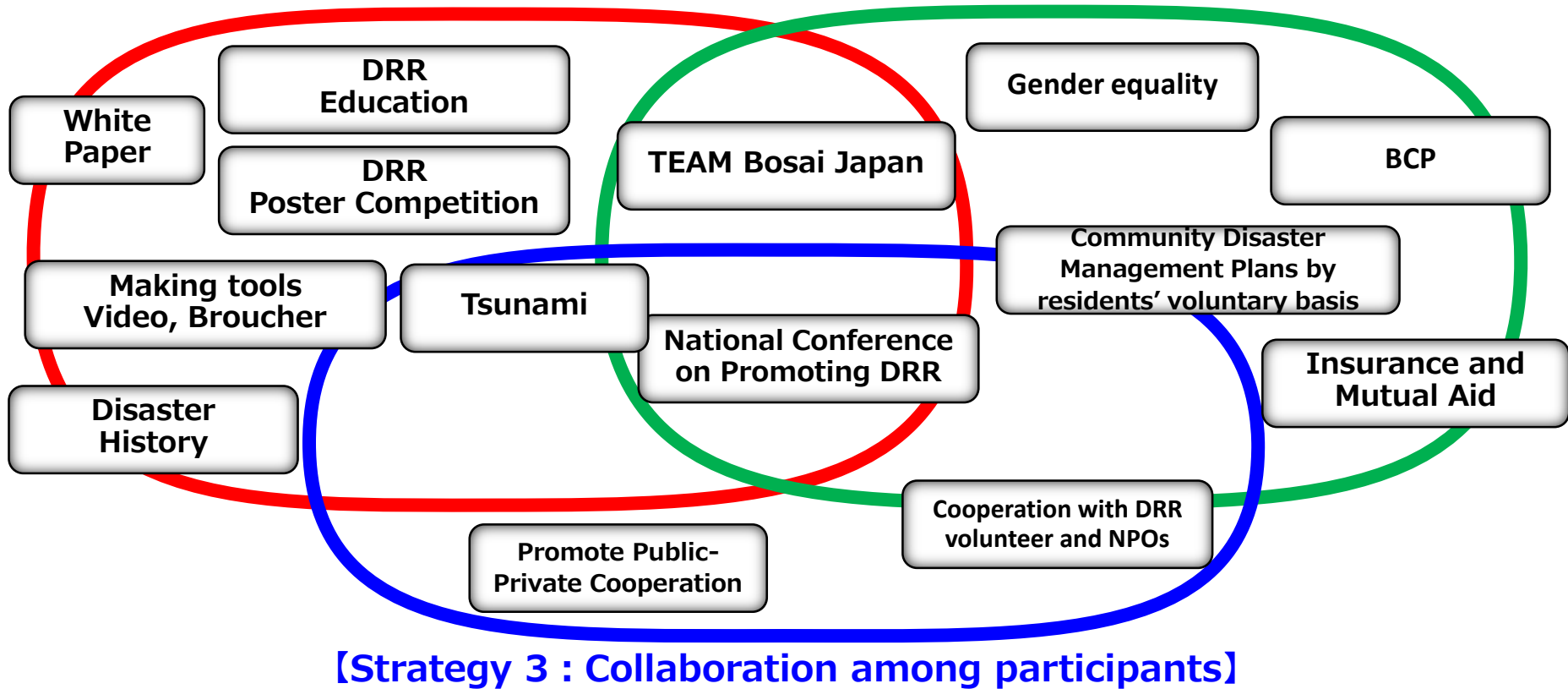

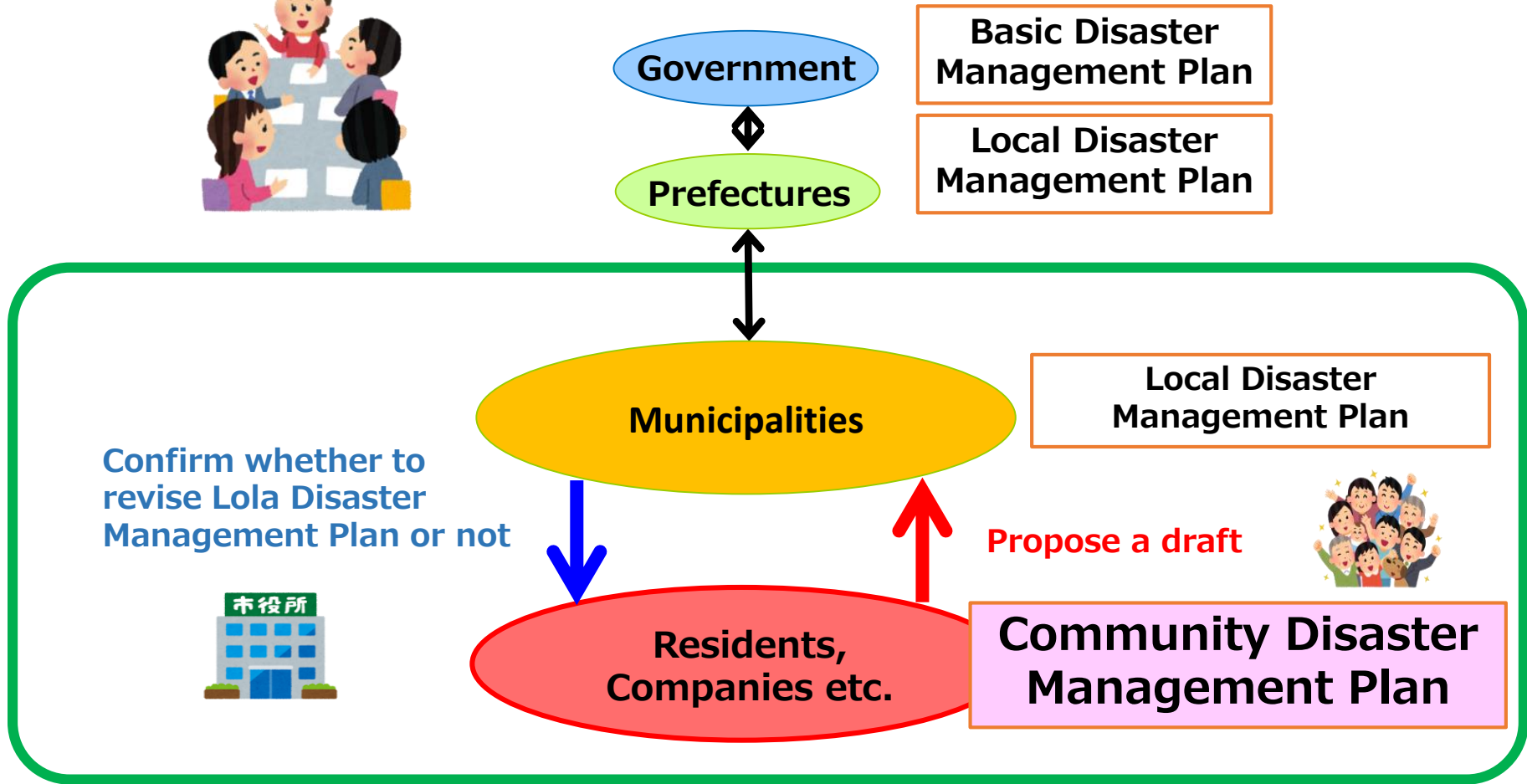

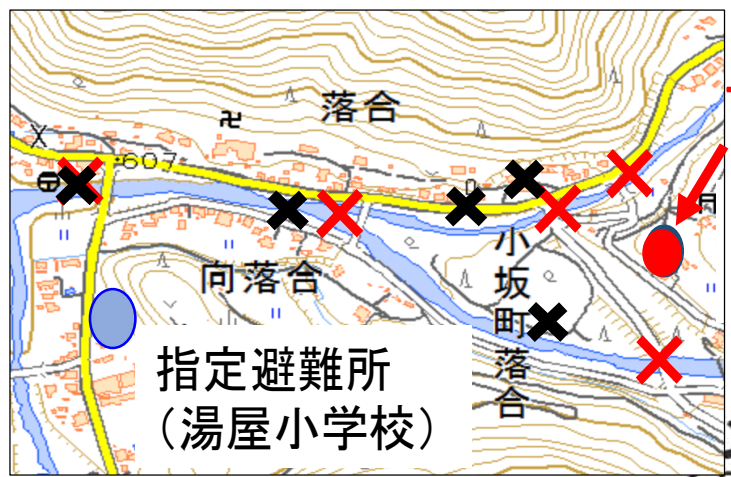
Cooperation among residents: Outline of local disaster management plan system (FY 2014 -)

Gifu Prefecture, Kosakamachi, Ochiai area

Designated a temporary evacuation site in the area.

69 tenants in the building jointly implemented drills and planned stockpiling.

Fukuoka Prefecture, Asakura City

Formulated Voluntary Disaster Management Map and distributed it to all the households.

The workshops and evacuation drills were jointly implemented by the factory workers and residents of Naruto City.

EXPECTED OUTCOME

The substantial reduction of disaster risk and losses in lives, livelihoods and health and in the economic, physical, social, cultural and environmental assets of persons, businesses, communities and countries.

GOAL

Prevent new and reduce existing disaster risk through the implementation of integrated and inclusive economic, structural, legal, social, health, cultural, educational, environmental, technological, political and institutional measures that prevent and reduce hazard exposure and vulnerability to disaster, increase preparedness for response and recovery, and thus strengthen resilience.
